1. Introduction

Welcome to <https://isps.space>, operated by the International Strategic Planning Services (ISPS), a strategic planning consultancy based in Port Vila, Vanuatu. These Terms and Conditions (“Terms”) govern your access to and use of our website, the Pacific Project and Funding Intelligence Hub (“Hub”), and all services provided by ISPS, including strategic planning, project intelligence, and related consultancy services across Pacific Island Countries and Territories (PICTs). By accessing our website, engaging our services, or using the Hub, you agree to be bound by these Terms, our [Privacy Policy](#), and any additional agreements specific to your engagement with ISPS.

ISPS is not a law firm, accounting firm, tax advisory, financial planner, or investment advisor, and does not provide or charge for such services. We are a strategic planning consultancy that develops plans considering commercial, political, and legal realities across international boundaries, a field not regulated by law in any country, including Vanuatu. All mandates undertaken by ISPS are protected by Intellectual Property, Confidentiality, Non-Disclosure, Non-Solicitation, and Non-Circumvention treaties, as detailed at <https://izak.co.za/mandate%20questionnaire.htm>.

By engaging ISPS or accessing our information, you implicitly agree to indemnify ISPS, its affiliates, and third parties against any losses arising from reliance on our advice or services, as outlined in Section 9. If you do not agree with these Terms, please do not use our website or services.

2. Definitions

- **ISPS:** International Strategic Planning Services, a consultancy based in Port Vila, Vanuatu.
- **Website:** <https://isps.space>, including all subdomains and pages.
- **Hub:** The Pacific Project and Funding Intelligence Hub, a digital platform providing project and funding intelligence for PICTs.
- **Services:** Strategic planning, project intelligence, capacity-building resources, and related consultancy services provided by ISPS.
- **User:** Any individual, organization, government entity, or stakeholder accessing the website, Hub, or Services.

- **Mandate:** Any engagement, project, or consultancy agreement undertaken by ISPS with a User.

3. Scope of Services

ISPS provides strategic planning consultancy services, including but not limited to:

- Development of strategic plans considering commercial, political, and legal realities across international boundaries.
- Operation of the Pacific Project and Funding Intelligence Hub, offering project databases, funding trackers, stakeholder directories, capacity-building resources, and a secure intelligence oversight module.
- Facilitation of partnerships and intelligence-sharing with Pacific regional bodies (e.g., Melanesian Spearhead Group, Pacific Community, Pacific Islands Forum).

Clarification of Services:

- ISPS does not hold itself out as, nor provides services as, a lawyer, chartered accountant, tax specialist, financial planner, or investment planner, and does not charge for such services.
- Strategic planning is a specialized field not regulated by law in any country, including Vanuatu, where ISPS is based. Our expertise lies in synthesizing commercial, political, and legal considerations to deliver actionable plans tailored to Pacific and international contexts.

Mandate Protections:

- All mandates undertaken by ISPS are protected by Intellectual Property, Confidentiality, Non-Disclosure, Non-Solicitation, and Non-Circumvention treaties, as detailed at <https://izak.co.za/mandate%20questionnaire.htm>. Users engaging ISPS agree to abide by these treaties, which prohibit unauthorized use, disclosure, or circumvention of ISPS's work, strategies, or relationships.

4. User Responsibilities

By using our website, Hub, or Services, you agree to:

5. Access to the Pacific Project and Funding Intelligence Hub

The Hub provides free and premium access tiers:

- **Free Access:** Available to grassroots NGOs and community organizations, offering limited access to project databases, funding trackers, and resources.
- **Premium Access:** Subscription-based (USD 100–1,500/year), providing full access to all features, including the secure intelligence oversight module for authorized users (e.g., Island administrations, MSG officials).
- **Secure Module Access:** Restricted to verified users, requiring additional authentication (e.g., government ID, institutional affiliation) to access blockchain-tracked intelligence reports.

Subscription Terms:

- Subscriptions are billed annually and non-refundable, except as required by law.
- ISPS reserves the right to modify subscription fees with 30 days' notice via email or website announcement.
- Unauthorized sharing of premium access credentials may result in account suspension.

6. Intellectual Property

All content, materials, and technologies on the website and Hub, including text, graphics, databases, AI algorithms, blockchain systems, and strategic plans, are owned by ISPS or its licensors and protected by international intellectual property laws. This includes:

- Project and funding intelligence data.
- Capacity-building resources in English, French, Bislama, Tongan, and Samoan.

12. Termination

- **Negotiation:** Parties will attempt to resolve disputes amicably through good-faith negotiations within 30 days.
- **Mediation:** If unresolved, disputes will be submitted to mediation in Port Vila, Vanuatu, under the Vanuatu Arbitration Association's rules.
- **Governing Law:** These Terms are governed by the laws of Vanuatu, without regard to conflict of law principles.
- **Jurisdiction:** Any legal action shall be brought exclusively in the courts of Port Vila, Vanuatu, unless otherwise agreed.

ISPS encourages Pacific cultural dispute resolution practices (e.g., community mediation) where appropriate, respecting local traditions.

14. Force Majeure

ISPS shall not be liable for delays or failures to perform due to events beyond our reasonable control, including but not limited to:

- Natural disasters (e.g., cyclones, volcanic eruptions like Ambae, earthquakes).
- Geoengineering impacts (e.g., Stratospheric Aerosol Injection-related disruptions).

16. Additional Terms for Pacific Context

- **Cultural Sensitivity:** ISPS commits to respecting Pacific cultural practices (e.g., kastom, fa'a Samoa) in all Services, consulting community leaders to ensure alignment. Users must respect these values when engaging with the Hub or mandates.
- **Geopolitical Neutrality:** ISPS maintains a “friends to all, enemies to none” approach, as reflected in the Hub’s intelligence oversight module, avoiding bias in U.S.-China tensions or West Papua issues.
- **Pacific Data Sovereignty:** Data is stored on Pacific-based servers (e.g., Vanuatu, Fiji) to comply with regional laws, with blockchain ensuring transparency.
- **Skepticism of Climate Schemes:** ISPS does not support carbon credit schemes or taxes linked to contested global warming narratives, focusing instead on addressing tangible vulnerabilities like geoengineering impacts and natural disasters.
